Mayor's Report

- 2. With the Holiday Season upon us, drivers are reminded to use designated drivers if they plan to celebrate with alcoholic drinks.
- 3. Congratulations are extended to Jude Dempsey, son of Chief of Police William Dempsey, on the completion of his Eagle Scout Project. Jude created a Rock Garden and Veteran's memorial behind the Third Street playground in the Borough of St. Clair. The projects primary goal was to honor and show appreciation for our local veterans by establishing a serene and meaningful space that incorporated flags representing all branches of the military, the American Flag, and Prisoner of War Flag. The project centerpiece features the arrangement of rocks in the shape of the letters "S" and "C' symbolizing St. Clair. The Rock Garden and Veterans Memorial provides a place for community members to reflect and pay their respects.

Historical Note

The first monument to veterans in St. Clair was proposed by the St. Clair Monument Association after the conclusion of the Civil War. The monument was procured at a cost of \$2,600. It was erected in the Odd Fellows Cemetery, and dedicated on Thanksgiving Day in 1874.

During the Civil War, Pennsylvania furnished the greatest quota of soldiers in all of the United States of America. Schuylkill County provided the largest per capita number of soldiers in Pennsylvania; and St. Clair responded with the highest percentage of soldiers in Schuylkill County.
