<u>ATTENTION RESIDENTS</u>: In the interest of Public and Borough Lineman's safety, zoning and building permits are required when installing **Customer Owned Generating Systems to homes** and other facilities in the Borough of St. Clair.

<u>ATTENTION LANDLORDS</u>: Rental Ordinance #398 requires a **Rental Registration** Form completed at the beginning of each year. Please complete your Rental Registration form along with fees and return to St. Clair Borough. The form is on the St. Clair Borough website under "Documents and Forms." All renters are required to be registered. <u>IT IS A REQUIREMENT.</u>

<u>ATTENTION RESIDENTS</u>: When a snow emergency is declared, there will be NO PARKING ALLOWED on SECOND STREET and HANCOCK STREET. Watch for posting of streets.

<u>ATTENTION RESIDENTS</u>: Please be mindful of our **Snow Removal Ordinance** which states that a path on the sidewalk, free of snow and ice, of at least 24 inches, must be maintained before 12 noon of the next day after snow has fallen. Also, when removing snow and ice from the sidewalk, it is unlawful to place snow or ice into the street or any public thorofare of the Borough.

The **St. Clair Area Food Pantry** offers a <u>drive thru pick up</u> on N. Mill Street on the second Thursday of every month from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m., at the First Primitive Methodist Church, 115 N. Mill Street, Saint Clair.
