

ORDINANCE NO. 316

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE  
OF SLEIGHS AND SKATEBOARDS ON BOROUGH STREETS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED pursuant to  
Section 6109 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, by the  
Borough Council of the Borough of St. Clair, and it is hereby  
enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to ride on  
a sled upon any street, sidewalk, lane or alley within the Borough  
of St. Clair. Provided, however, that nothing in this Ordinance  
shall prevent a pedestrian from pulling a sled, with or without a  
rider, upon any sidewalk, street, lane or alley in a safe and  
reasonable manner.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to ride on  
a skateboard upon any street, sidewalk, lane or alley within the  
Borough of St. Clair, except that nothing in this Ordinance shall  
prevent a pedestrian from pulling a coaster or other toy vehicle,  
with or without a rider, upon a sidewalk.

SECTION 3: Any person violating the provisions of this  
Ordinance, upon summary conviction, shall be liable to a fine of  
not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and not more than Three  
Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution for

each violation.
