## WINTER WEATHER ALERTS:



**Habitual placing of cones, chairs, or any other item on a public street to save a parking space is considered abandoned property and will be taken away by our sanitation and police departments.**

When a **snow emergency** is declared, there will be **NO PARKING ALLOWED** on **SECOND STREET** and **HANCOCK STREET**. Watch for posting of streets.

Please be mindful of our **Snow Removal Ordinance** which states that a path on the sidewalk, free of snow and ice, of at least 24 inches, must be maintained before 12 noon of the next day after snow has fallen. Also, when removing snow and ice from the sidewalk, it is unlawful to place snow or ice into the street or any public thoroughfare of the Borough.

Historical Note

On February 17, 1776, the first volume of Edward Gibbon's essential work, "The History of the Rise and Fall of the Roman Empire" was published in England. This work would have a lasting impact on historical scholarship.
