### **Historical Note**

1. On May 4, 1776, Rhode Island became the first colony to renounce allegiance to George III.
2. On May 5, 1776, The Virginia Convention instructed its delegates to the Second Continental Congress to propose a resolution for independence from Great Britain.
3. On May 19, 1776, a continental army garrison surrendered at the Battle of the Cedars during the Colonial Invasion of Canada.
