E-Bikes & Motorized Scooters in Pennsylvania



1 E-BIKES (PEDALCYCLES WITH ELECTRIC ASSIST)



- **Age Limit:** You **MUST** be at least 16 years of age to operate an e-bike in Pennsylvania.
- **Requirements:** E-bikes are legally treated as bicycles. You do not need a driver's license, titling, registration, or insurance to ride one.
- To qualify as an e-bike, the vehicle must have operable pedals, weigh no more than 100 lbs, have a motor up to 750 watts, and have a max motor-powered speed of 20 mph.

2 MOTORIZED SCOOTERS

2 wheels, electric/gas powered,
with NO seat or saddle



- **The Law:** Motorized scooters **CANNOT** be operated on Pennsylvania roadways or sidewalks.
- **Why?** These vehicles do not meet PA's safety equipment and inspection standards for motor vehicles, meaning they cannot be legally titled or registered in the state.
