PUBLIC NOTICE

Full-Time Police Officer – Borough of Saint Clair, PA

Qualified persons are invited to apply to the Borough of Saint Clair Civil Service Commission to take competitive examinations leading to eligibility for appointment as a Full-Time Police Officer in the Borough of Saint Clair Police Department.

Applications may be obtained in person, by the applicant, beginning Tuesday, August 4, 2026 and are available to be picked up, through Friday, August 7, 2026 at Saint Clair Borough Hall, 16 South 3rd Street, Saint Clair, PA 17970, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. The completed applications must be returned in person, by the applicant, no later than Thursday, August 20, 2026 by 3:00 p.m. Applicants will be required to produce positive identification in the form of a valid picture driver license when obtaining and submitting the application packet.

Applicants must be a citizen of the United States, have graduated from an accredited high school or have a GED (Graduate Equivalency Diploma), and possess an Act 120 diploma, current MPOETC (Municipal Police Officer Education Training Commission) card and be employed as a MPOETC certified police officer at the time of application. Further, candidates must possess a valid Pennsylvania Driver's License and must be at least 21 years of age at the time of application. The required seventy-five dollar (\$75.00) non-refundable processing fee, payable by check or money order to the Borough of Saint Clair must be included at the time of submission. Additional qualifications will be provided at the time of application. The Borough of Saint Clair is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
