Historical Note

1. The actual signing of the Declaration of Independence by most of the 56 delegates occurred on August 2, 1776.
2. The Battle of Long Island was fought August 27 – 29, 1776 in present day Brooklyn, N.Y. British General William Howe decisively defeated the Colonial Army under General George Washington.
3. On August 30, 1776, the Continental Army escaped destruction and fell back to Manhattan, N.Y.
